1. Introductions/Apologies

2. Health, Safety and Wellbeing				
We were reminded of the stress that can be experienced during very busy and pressured periods, such as leading up to and during public consultations. We can help each other by recognizing the signs of stress, actively listening and providing support during these challenging periods.	No actions			
3. Project Update				
HE gave an update on the announcement made earlier that day on the timing of the further consultation. The consultation is planned for late summer and will be carried out over an eight-week period. The forum discussed why it is taking longer than expected to launch the consultation. HE stated that we need to ensure that we have consistent analysis across all the options that are being considered for further consultation. We are investigating a number of options which haven't previously been consulted on and are working hard to finalise analysis on these as quickly as possible. This requires significant time to carry out studies of the new information and what it might means for all route options. Attendees expressed disappointment that consultation was delayed but there was group consensus that it was important that thorough and robust assessments were carried out consistently for all options that were being considered. HE confirmed that the start of construction is delayed and is looking like summer 2022. Despite delays HE confirmed that the A27 Arundel scheme funding is in place through the Regional Investment Strategy 1 (RIS1) programme and is on the list for the RIS2 programme.	No actions

those that were currently being assessed and are at a formative stage. It is not possible to show specific route alignments because as the assessments progresses it is possible that changes may be made. Therefore we are only presenting broad corridors as shown in the plan.

The final options for consultation will be decided closer to the start of public consultation, after the work is complete and the alignments have been agreed internally. The full information supporting the assessments will be shared with the public at this time.

The need for and number of route junctions being considered were discussed, particularly focusing on the Ford Road junction. HE noted that they are undertaking work to assess the benefits and impacts of including a junction at Ford Road for the offline options. This will be presented as a part of the further public consultation.

Other topics discussed during the meeting were:

- indicative locations of the route corridors relative to ancient woodland, South Downs National Park and local communities were discussed.
- Traffic and congestion through Arundel and around Crossbush roundabout
- · Grade separation at the eastern end at Crossbush
- A284 north-south link road from the A27 at Crossbush and proposed Lyminster Bypass
- Information supporting the traffic modellling of the junctions and route options being considered will be made available at consultation.
