NOTICE is hereby given that Public Inquiries in connection with the Orders mentioned below will be held by an Inspector, appointed for this purpose by the Secretary of State for Transport, **beginning at 10.00 am on 11 March 2020 at Mercure Brandon Hall Hotel & Spa Warwickshire, Main St, Brandon, Coventry CV8 3FW**. This is to hear representations from remaining objectors (as defined in the Compulsory Purchase (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 2007), statutory objectors (as defined in the Highways (Inquiries Procedure) Rules 1994), from any other persons having an interest in the land the subject of the Compulsory Purchase Order and, at his discretion, to hear representations from any other persons who may desire to appear and be heard.

THE ORDERS are Orders which have been made by Highways England under the above-mentioned Acts and submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation. Namely:-

(1) THE HIGHWAYS ENGLAND THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (COVENTRY JUNCTIONS UPGRADE (BINLEY)) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2019. *An Order under section 14 of the Highways Act 1980*

(2) THE HIGHWAYS ENGLAND THE A46 TRUNK ROAD (COVENTRY JUNCTIONS UPGRADE (BINLEY)) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2019. *An Order under sections 239, 240, 241, 242, 246 and 250 of the Highways Act 1980*

relating to highways and land all on or in the vicinity of the classified road known as the A46 Coventry Eastern Bypass, within the City of Coventry, the parish of Binley Woods and the borough of Rugby, in the County of Warwickshire.

PROCEEDINGS on the above-mentioned Orders are being taken concurrently by virtue of Section 257 of the Highways Act 1980.
