



WISLEY COMMON AND CHATLEY HEATH

Highways England has applied to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for consent under section 38 of the Commons Act 2006 to carry out restricted works on Wisley Common and Chatley Heath, Surrey. The Planning Inspectorate will decide the application on behalf of the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs.

The proposed works are temporary and include fencing, trenches/pits and exploratory holes for ground investigation. The area this will cover shall be up to 150m² at any one given time, i.e. per exploratory hole location. Each exploratory hole location will be temporarily fenced to ensure safety during works and any resultant groundwater or ground gas installation will be temporarily fenced, to ensure safety, for the duration of the monitoring period. The monitoring period for these locations will be a minimum of 6 months.

The works and subsequent fencing will be located on Common Land adjacent to the A3 and M25.
