HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

**THE A2 TRUNK ROAD (BEAN AND EBBSFLEET JUNCTION IMPROVEMENTS)
(SLIP ROADS AND ROUNDABOUTS) ORDER 2020**

**THE HIGHWAYS ENGLAND (A2 TRUNK ROAD BEAN AND EBBSFLEET
JUNCTION IMPROVEMENTS) (SIDE ROADS) ORDER 2019**

THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR TRANSPORT hereby gives notice that, on 27 May 2020, he has made the above titled Slip Roads Order and confirmed, with modifications, the above titled Side Roads Order.

(1) The Slip Roads Order is an Order under Section 10 of the Highways Act 1980 and which, as made, authorises that the new slip roads at Bean Junction and new slip roads and roundabout extension at Ebbsfleet Junction which are proposed to be constructed by Highways England along the routes described in the Schedule to the Order shall become trunk roads and that Highways England Company Limited, as a strategic highways company, shall become the highway authority for those trunk roads from the date when the Order comes into force.

(2) The Side Roads Order is an Order under Sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 which, as confirmed, authorises Highways England to –

- (a) improve highways (including raising, lowering or otherwise altering);
- (b) stop up highways;
- (c) construct new highways;
- (d) stop up private means of access to premises; and
- (e) provide new means of access to premises

all on or in the vicinity of the A2 Trunk Road.

ANY PERSON aggrieved by or desiring to question the validity of any provision within the Slip Roads Order or Side Roads Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement or regulation made has not been complied with, may, within 6 weeks of 11 June 2020, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Slip Roads Order or Side Roads Order or of any provision included.
