

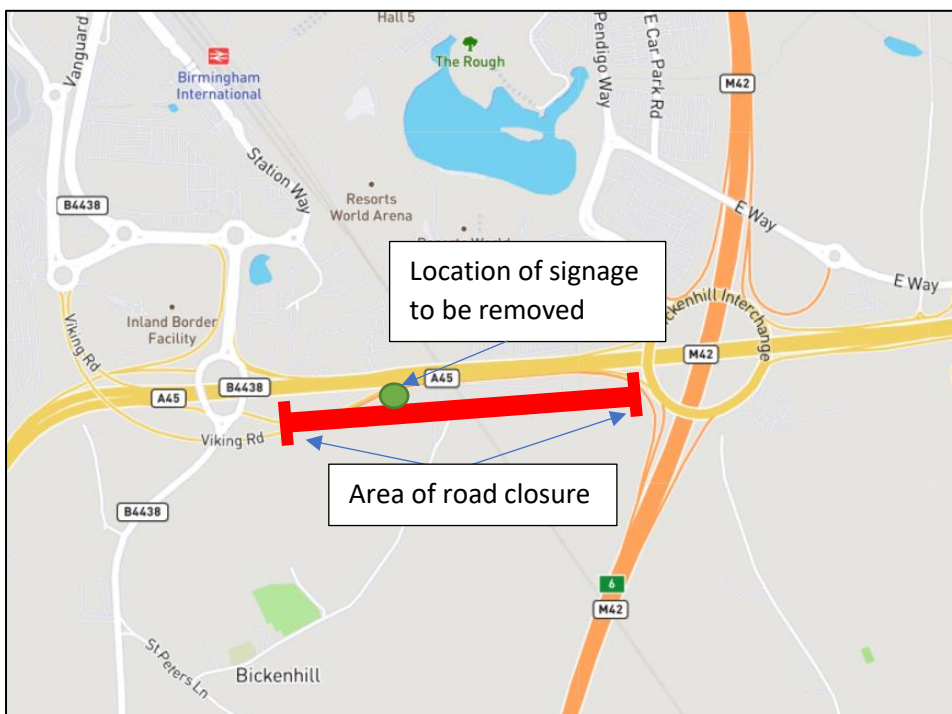
M42 Junction 6 Improvement Scheme

Advanced Notification of Work – March 21

Advanced notice of A45 road closure

As part of the **M42 junction 6 improvement scheme** we need to remove some overhead signage on the A45 to allow the construction of the planned A45 pedestrian footbridge. To reduce the impact of this closure on local stakeholders, community members, and the road user this work will be carried out across 3 nights, with the road reopening during the day. The closure is required to ensure we carry the work out in a way that keeps both the public and our workforce safe.

We will be closing the A45 between the Clock interchange roundabout and M42 junction 6 on **Monday 29, Tuesday 30, and Wednesday 31 March**. The road will be closed between **9pm and 6am**.

Duration of works

- Night-time working: 9:00 pm to 6:00 am
- We will be on site up to one hour before the closure
- 3 nights from 29th March 2021

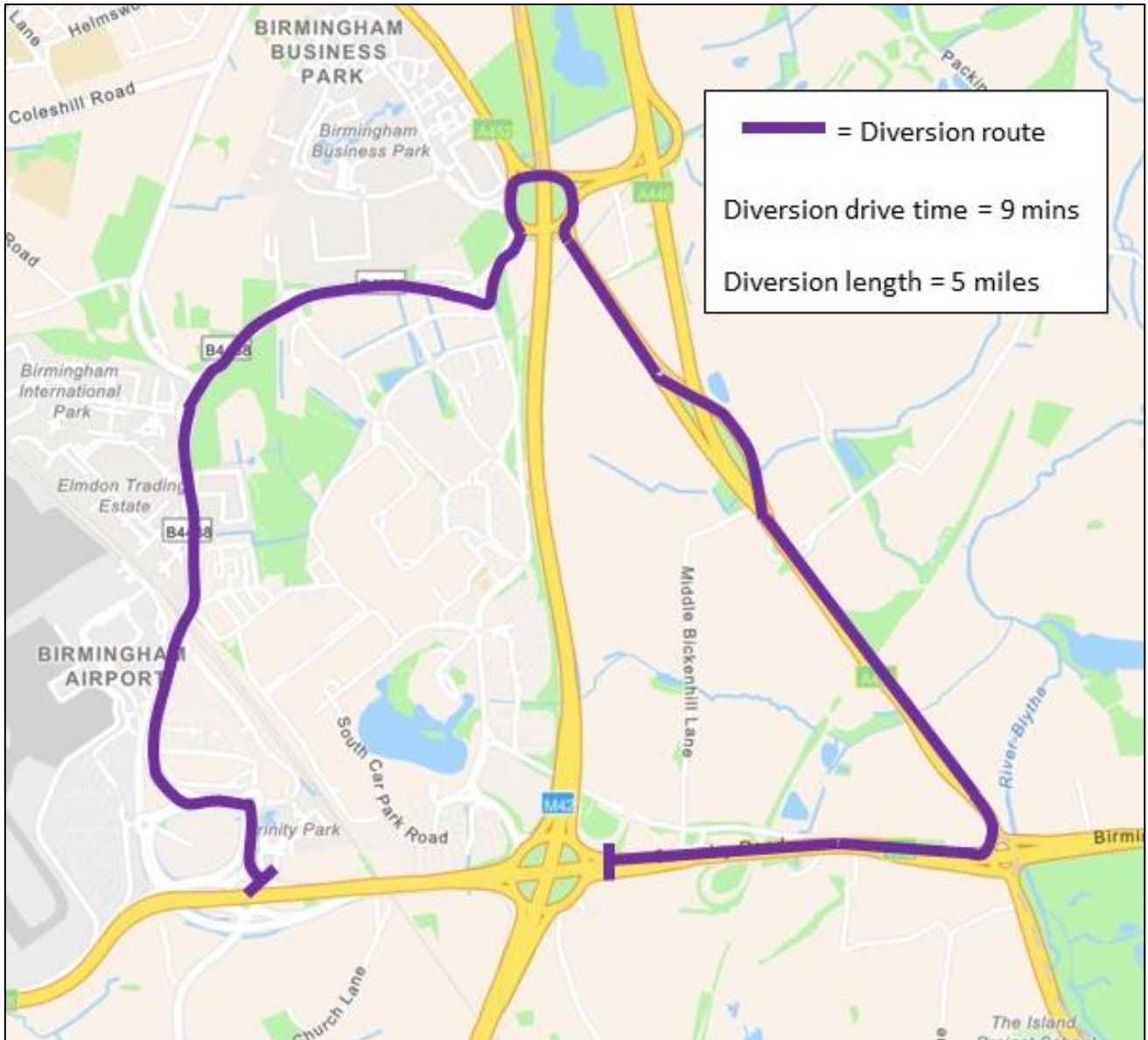
What to expect

- A full road closure of the A45 between Clock Interchange and M42 junction 6
- A diversion to be in place
- No access to any businesses within the closure via the A45

What we will do

- Work in a way that minimises the amount of noise we make
- Keep the site safe, secure and tidy
- Remove the closure during the day
- Install clear diversion signage
